Noticed most students are on track. Wonder how these numbers/data may change in the next few years (post-covid)?

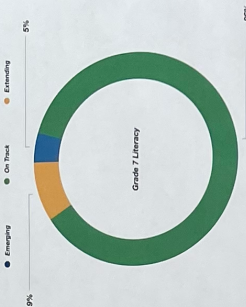
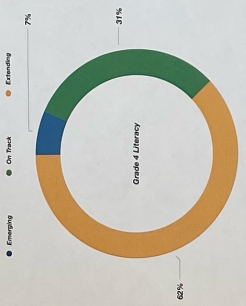
FSA data differs from Reported Proficiency is teacher driven
