Attendance	Volunteers help Mrs. Fung to follow up with parents/guardians of students who are not accounted for.
Counts	Time commitment: Approximately 15-30 minutes once per month.
Safe Arrival	
SAFETY	At the crosswalk at the entrance to the main school parking lot, volunteers assist pedestrians and manage traffic flow in and out of the parking lot. There may be student helpers to assist.
Traffic Safety	Time commitment: Morning shift 8:25 – 8:50 am, afternoon shift 2:30pm-2:55pm once per week.
School Janen	Volunteers are needed to distribute pre-order lunches, sell food, serve pizza and count cash.
Hot Lunch	Time commitment: 30-40 minutes per hot lunch, 1-2 times per month.
	Two parent representatives from each division are required. The reps will take photos of students in their division at school events throughout the year. The reps will then sort the photos, and submit them via Google Drive to the Yearbook Committee.
Yearbook	Time commitment: Approximately 30 minutes, 1-2 times per month.
1	Volunteers wash and prepare fruits and vegetables that are donated to the school and distribute them to classrooms.
Fruit & Vegetable Program	Time commitment: Approximately 30 minutes twice a month.
	Volunteers assist the PAC and the school with translation of important information and notices into Mandarin as needed.
Multicultural	Time commitment: Varies with length of document. Help needed 1-4 times per year.

EVENTS	Volunteers help the Special Events Coordinator with events such as Terry Fox Run and Staff Appreciation Luncheon. Time commitment: Varies depending on event.

RDPA	The RDPA is the Richmond District Parents Association, which has monthly meetings at the Richmond School Board Office. The volunteer would attend 1 (or more meetings) and report any relevant information back to our PAC.
	Time commitment: Once per month for two hours.
