Fundraising Update

The PAC would like to send out a big thank you to the 48 families who have donated a total of \$5,470 to the PAC this year.

PAC funds are used to enhance student learning and experiences at school, for example the Bhangra dancing at our winter concert and projectors in all classrooms for learning and student portfolios.

If each family donated \$50 per student, we would raise \$11,500 to enhance school resources. If each family donated \$100 per student, we would have \$23,000 and could purchase 2 class sets of iPads and 2 charging carts.

Donations are accepted throughout the year at the school office. Donations of more than \$25 are eligible for a tax receipt. Please see the attached form.

PAC fundraising priorities for the remainder of this year and next year:

- A class set of iPads and charging cart to enhance student learning with technology and use of student portfolios. Approximately \$12,000.
- 2. Starting to save for an expansion or replacement of our playground.

Please note that regardless of what the General Donation Form says, all funds will go to support Thompson students.

Did you know schools need to have a PAC in order to have a hot lunch program and to receive the BC Gaming Grant for schools? This year we received \$5,208 from the BC government for having a PAC.

How do PAC volunteers help at the school?

Safe Arrival: Volunteers help Mrs. Fung to follow up with parents/guardians of students who are not accounted for.

Hot Lunch: Volunteers distribute pre-order lunches, sell food, serve pizza and count cash.

Yearbook: Each division has two parent representatives. The reps take photos of students in their division at school events throughout the year. The reps sort the photos, and submit them via Google Drive to the Yearbook Committee.

Fruit and Vegetable Program: Volunteers wash and prepare fruits and vegetables that are donated to the school and distribute them to classrooms.

Special Events: Volunteers help the Special Events Coordinator with events such as Terry Fox Run and Staff Appreciation Luncheon.
