In Richmond Elementary Schools , we are introducing a new way to access your child's school information directly online. Between November 18th – 30th, the MyEducation BC PARENT PORTAL will be initiated which will allow parents and/or guardians to access attendance, term grades, report cards and other information on their child(ren). **Term 1 Report Cards will be available through MyEd Dec. 14th-Jan. 25th.**

Each parent/guardian will have their own separate account, and can view the following:

- Attendance Information
- Contact Information
- Student Demographic Information
- Published Report Cards
- Transcript Information

In November, you will receive an email from "sysadmin@myeducation.gov.bc.ca" with your login ID and temporary password. Login and navigate the Parent Portal at the website below. We have added this information to our school website as well.
