## Parking Lot Reminders

#### SAFETY IS OUR PRIORITY:

- Students and families are to ALWAYS walk on the outside of the parking lot and using the designated crosswalks
- Students should NEVER exit the car unless it is parked in a designated parking spot or in the drop off line, along the sidewalk curb
- Students and families should NEVER walk through the parking lot
- For ease and flow we ask that you refer to the 'Parking Lot Info' below

- We have 20 designated parking spots for parents ideally our younger students
- Having designated parent parking is rare and not typical at most elementary schools
