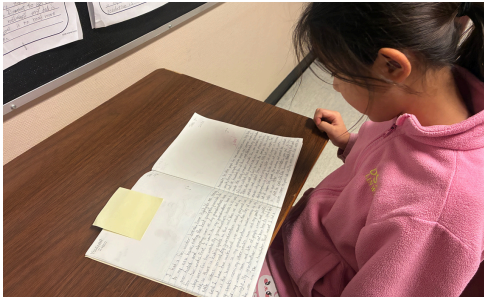
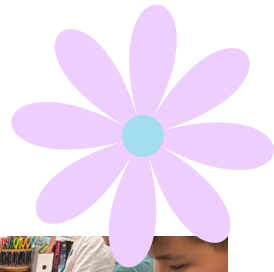

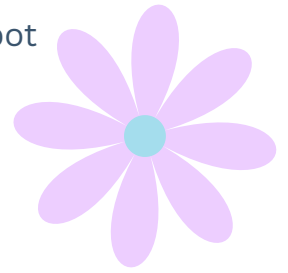

# SAFETY IS OUR PRIORITY: Parking Lot Reminders

- Students and families are to ALWAYS walk on the outside of the parking lot and using the designated crosswalks
- Students should NEVER exit the car unless it is parked in a designated parking spot or in the drop off line, along the sidewalk curb
- Students and families should NEVER walk through the parking lot

- With approximately 240 students; we encourage walking to school, if possible

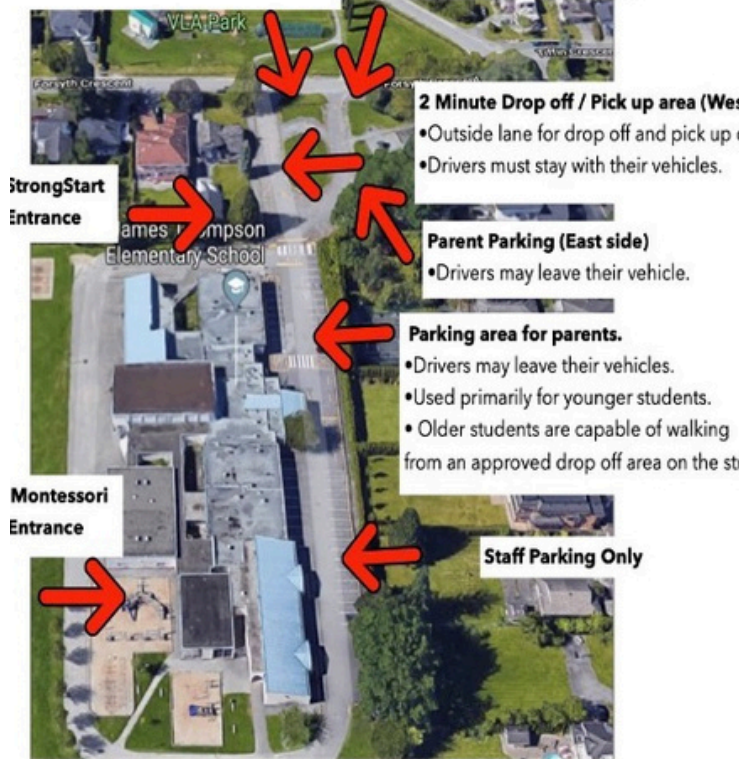
